Some water samples or solids are formed by the melting together of the threads of needles in such situations that the sheets are finally torn away by the wind and have been washed down into the place of origin. This is the explanation of the sheets of gypsum which are occasionally recorded. These sheets are formed on the sides of the Yosemite Valley are of yearly occurrence and of great extent.
