REMARKS: SOURCE was extremely cooperative and willing to recall minor details such as the exact time of sighting, time of call to BASHAW Field Center. SOURCE is absolutely certain that the object was a weather balloon and has estimated confidence to be reliable.

III.

SOURCE'S DESCRIPTION OF SIGHTING (UNCLASSIFIED)

1. SOURCE was on duty from 1910 to 1930 hours on 10-10-55. She estimated that at 1655 hours, the object was in sight for 75 minutes and in which time it moved from north to east. The object was a bright white color and appeared to be solid. It was the size of a large balloon and was inflated. SOURCE revealed no further details.

2. It was a clear day with a slight breeze. The object was much brighter than the background.

3. The object did not appear to stand still, coast up and down, sway at any time. It did not give off smoke nor change in shape, thickness, size or color.

4. SOURCE was definite that the object did not move in front of or behind anything. The object was a bright white color and appeared to be solid.

5. The top part of the object was clearly outlined while the bottom part was blurred, both with and without binoculars.

6. The object was not seen after observation when it was reported it disappeared in the east.

7. SOURCE was absolutely certain that the object was a weather balloon.

3. (Secret) The Air Defense Command, Los Angeles (ADCOM) has a program within the Western Air Defense Force Area. This program entails the release of radio detectable balloons. The following information was obtained from the Combat Operations Center, 27th Air Division, Norton AFB, California:

a. Ten (10) balloons were released from Van Nuys Naval Air Station, California (NANAS) at 10:00 (10) minutes interval, beginning at 201924Z Jan 55.

b. These balloons were balloons (17) feet in diameter and had a rate of ascent of 600 to 700 feet a minute.

c. These balloons were partially of plastic construction and were painted white.

d. The particular balloons mentioned in subparagraph b. above were set for a daily altitude of 35,000 feet.
