BRIEF SUMMARY OF SIGHTING One (1) round sphere, silver in color, and estimated to be about the size of a basketball was observed to descend from high in the sky to the vicinity of some railroad tracks. However, no further evidence was later recovered.		11. COMMENTS The intelligence officer of the 648th AC&W Squadron stated that there were twelve other persons present at the time of the supposed sighting, but they reportedly saw nothing unusual. For this reason the report is strongly suggestive of an optical illusion.
