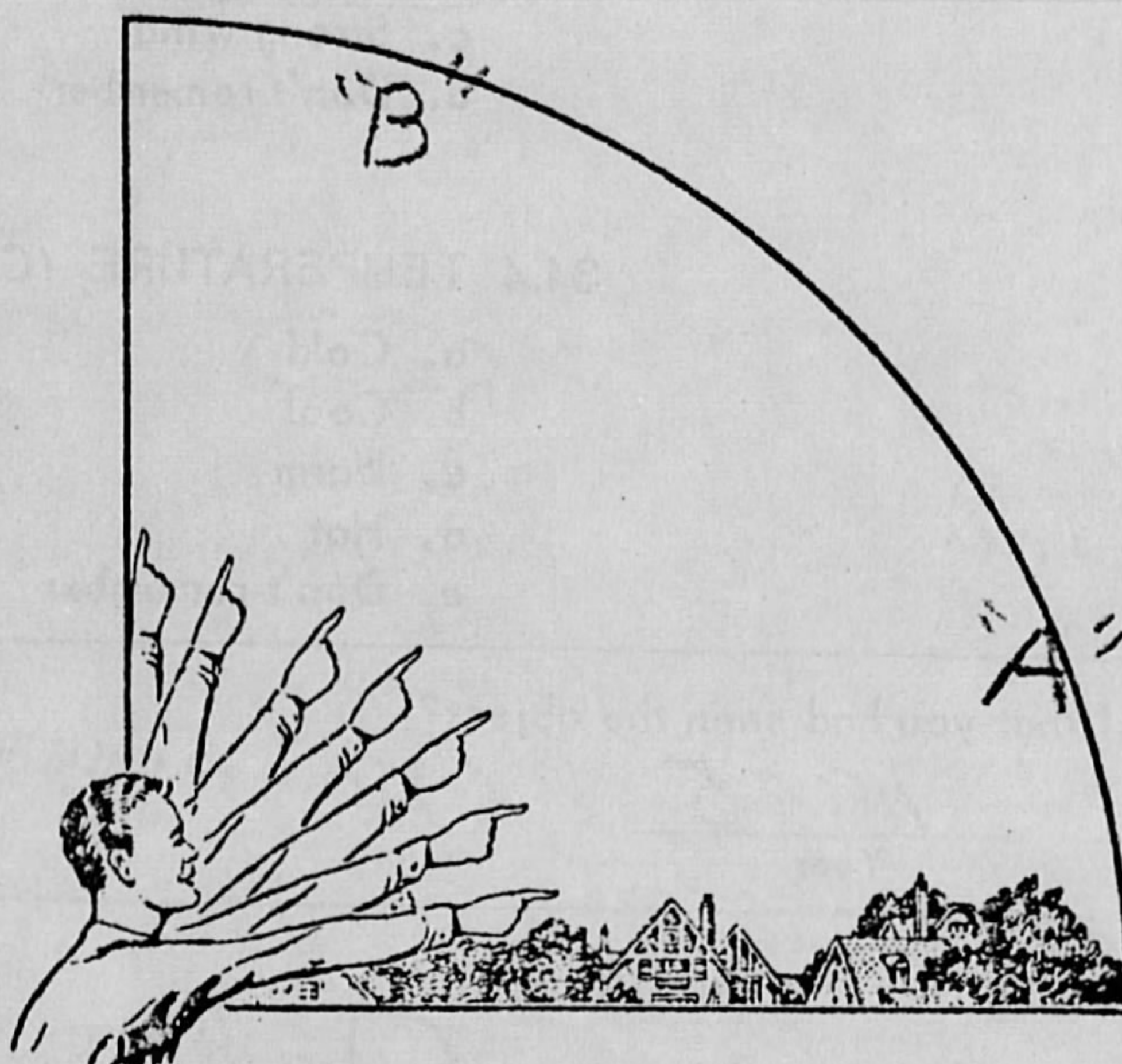

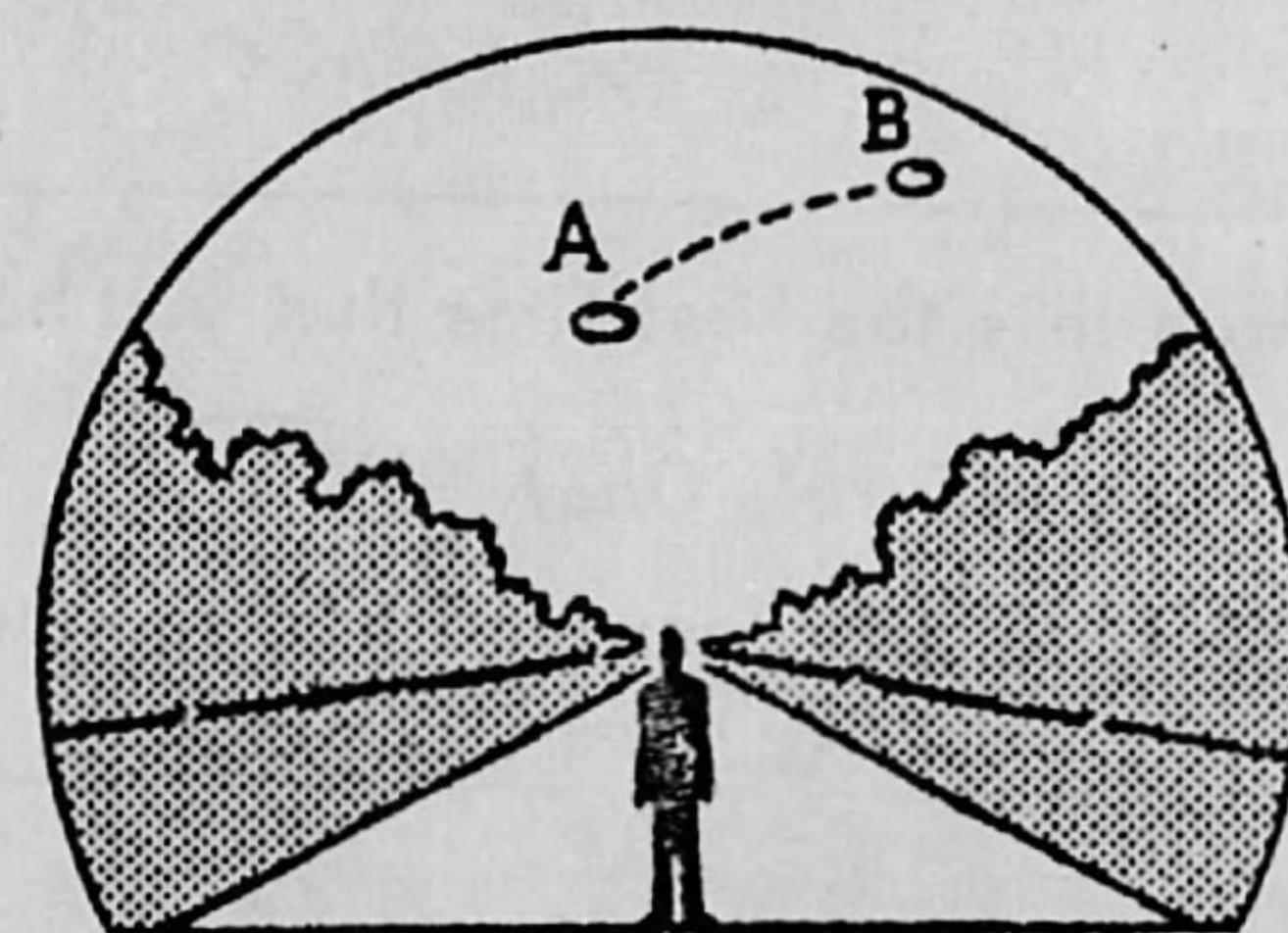

Sirs;

I want civil air patrol in note, more than once about two different type of object I explained the one pretty fully here is the other ball type one's seen. First seen between Oakland & Lyons on V.S. 77 I was going south heading home when out in West Valley low I saw this object it was large & white then moving slowly at speed at 45 or 50 M.P.H. in south direction. Went to a point on top of a hill object seemed to be settled above a certain point in West, went to Oakland got my brother come out and chased object but when we got to where I had seen it was gone, we later about 10-15 minutes later seen it in east above a hill blinking red, green white & some blueish tint, was stationary there and could be seen every night at some time around 8:30 until 9:00 or 9:30 when it would be up out of sight like any ordinary star. Then New Year's Eve I will never forget this it seemed living day-lights out of me. I had a date and was returning to parent from Lyons it was out of early

only about 12:30. When out of the west
through the clouds came a bunch of flashes
Red & white and seemed to be after me I could
not see anything but these blinding light they
scared me so I turned around headed to Oakland.

I hope I never see anything like that again
it was really scary. Lights came in a sort of
circular motion and were bright only lasted
for a few minutes at 2 or 3.

It has been along time since I seen
them so I can't be sure of dates but I will
never forget those lights & that wavy
object, I am sure of them they were
something that is for sure. And these
people still see them once in awhile.

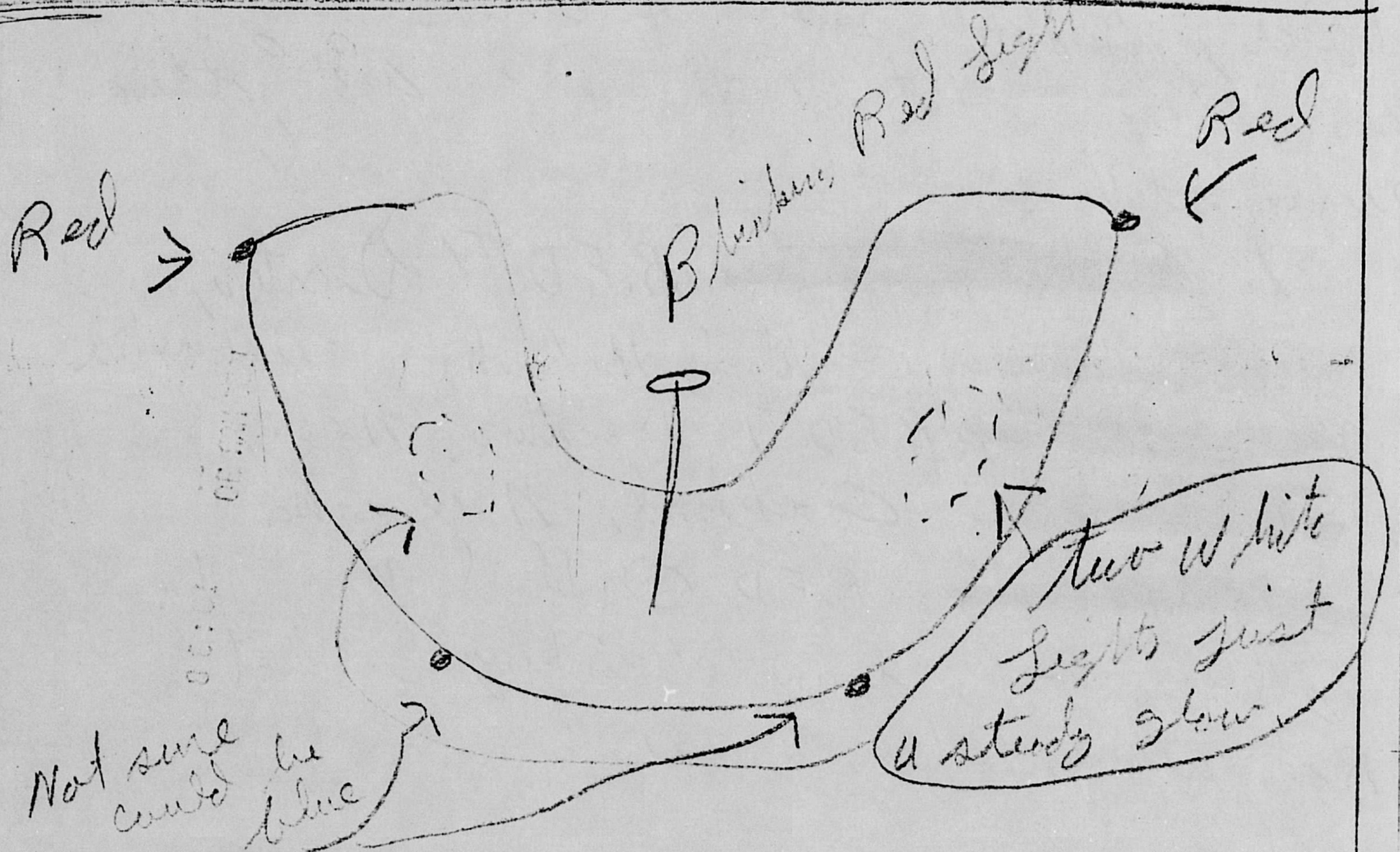
