Negative results were obtained when this hq tried to contact pilot of jet a/c seen just before object was seen. Both SOURCES admitted the possibility of the object having been a high flying a/c when queried. Lack of contrail and gain in speed convinced the SOURCES (at time of sighting) that the object was not an aircraft.
