751ST AC&W SQDN. 12. THE OBJECT WAS SIGHTED APPROXIMATELY 10 MILES
SOUTHWEST OF THE POST IN THE VICINITY OF THE DESTROYER BASE AT SAN DIEGO.
THE POSSIBILITY OF THE OBJECT BEING A BURNING AIRCRAFT WAS CHECKED.
NO EMERGENCIES COULD BE UNCOVERED. THE OBJECT WYARLLUFOED TWICE FOR A
DAURATION OF 3 TO 4 MIN. FIRST SIGHTING WAS AT CC 4845 AT 0411Z. THE
SECOND SIGHTING WAS AT CC 0527 AT 0427Z. THE OBJECT WAS TRAVELING
VERY SLOW. OBJECT WAS AT 1,000 TO 2,000 FEET ALTITUDE.
