Object was still in sight at time of initial report.		11. COMMENTS Sighting believed to be caused by planet Venus despite slight inconsistency in azimuth & elevation which can be attributed to error in human judgement. Temp inversion & scattered clouds account for color changes & disappearance & reappearance of obj. SW movement, time, & indication of long duration, further support evaluation as Venus.
