Eight cylindrical objects, red & green in color. Objects were in a staggered formation. Objects faded fm sight after being viewed visually for 38 minutes. Total of 18 objects observed. Objects moved in east to west behind each other at intervals ranging fm 3-15 mins. Total time of sighting was 1 hour, 15 minutes. The silver objects, about the size of an aircraft disappeared separately over the horizon. One object was larger and had a red light on top.
