No obj in air. However, scattered clouds and contrails, with searchlights up from Cleveland found. Proved repeatedly that blue or greenish-white beams often will blend with background, and only circular or elliptical reflection of searchlights underneath scattered clouds visible. This gives illusion of solid object moving rapidly in sky. Report states movement counter-clockwise in circle. This typical of searchlights. Reporting observers cannot be considered very reliable as to est size: basketball size at same length would make object almost 3 miles in diameter at given altitude.
