Statement later in letter includes remark that during the sighting he heard a roaring and buzzing sound.				11. COMMENTS Rpt received fm youth seven months after sighting. Heard roaring & //buzzing sound simultaneously. Reason for delay given was that it was his first sighting & he wanted to check on it. His final conclusion that it was an intelligently controlled spaceship & not from this planet gave no indication as to how this was reached. Case considered as unreliable rpt.
