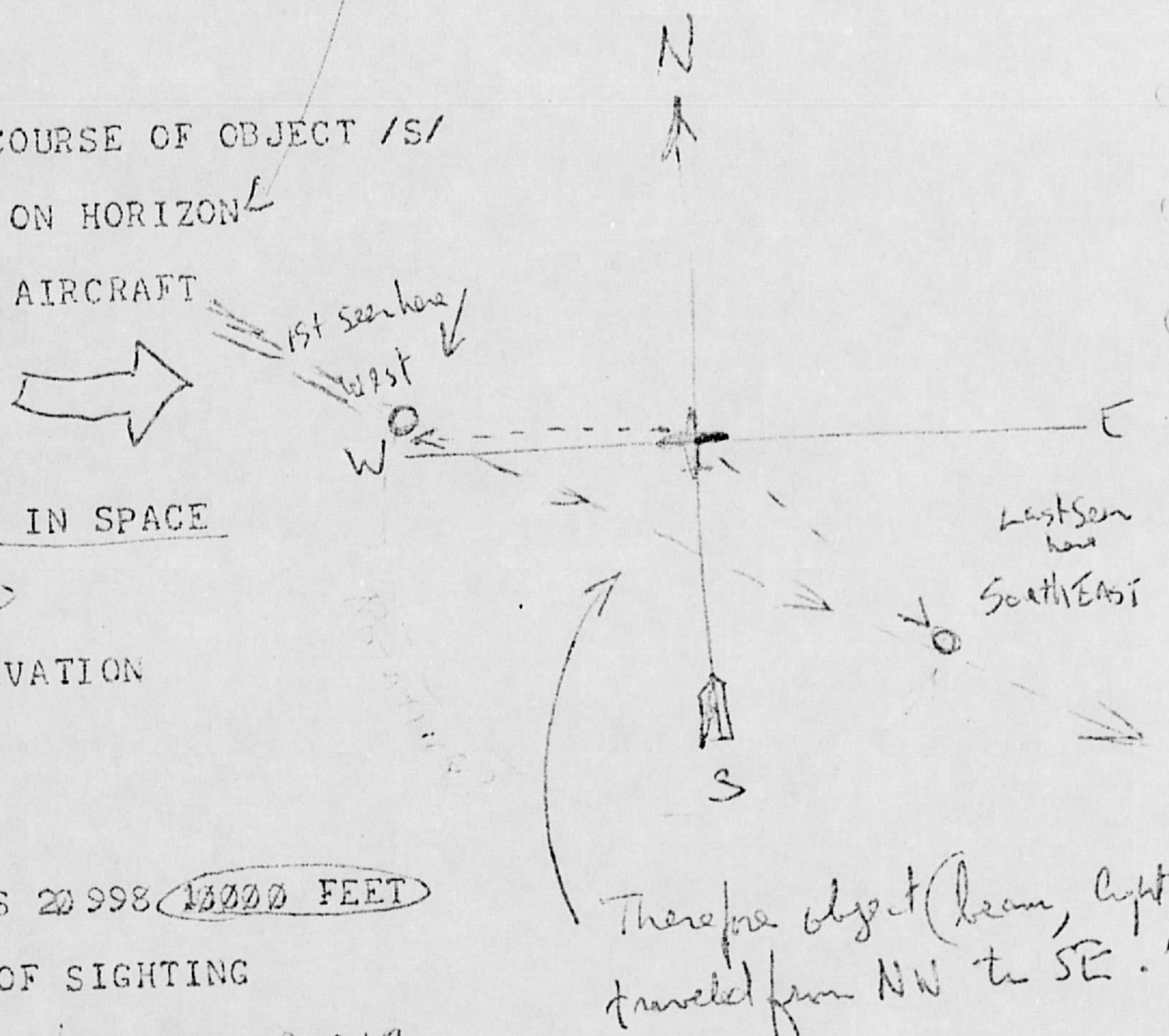

- ① White beam
 - ② Towards horizon, emanating from the horizon (12) apparently from water surface: very good clue.
 - ③ ^{Light} Apparently rotated from West to SE (semi-circular)
 - ④ Facility checks, shows W.S. Atlantic Wx Station #H situated near area where UFO sighted. These stations have rotating beacons and can be seen for long distances.
