(FOR 29) 308 = 20 hrs. 30 min (SHA) = FULL MOON (Elev. approx 20 deg SE)

(FOR 28) 308 - 13° = 295 = Prachell, FULL MOON (Elev. 15 degrees)
(That observers could possibly mistake the moon)

*ATTN Comment: Difficult to understand - yet object observed for 1 1/2 hours is given a description and elevations of practically the full moon - which is confirmed by Astro Tables and data. The "broader phenomenon" is well known. See Bulletin 100 release 5/10/57. Although everything points to obj. being the Moon, no conclusion positively because no direction or bearing given.
