10. BRIEF SUMMARY OF SIGHTING Elliptical obj estimated at 10ft x 20ft. A "real flying saucer." Aluminum, speed fast & then slow. Observed at alt of one mile descending to 13 ft. Direction of travel NE. Color silver. Rose by secret method of jerks & flops. No sound until obj exploded. 10 min obsvation during daylight. Made seven attempts to land in a field 500ft fm witness & then halted one ft above the ground where it remained motionless for exactly 5 mins. At this time a red glow started at 1 end & when the entire obj was glowing		11. COMMENTS it then exploded. Witness ran away. Has told everyone in the neighborhood but can't convince anyone it wasn't an hallucination. Apparently the witness believes that he saw an obj of some sort. No attempt at a hoax is indicated. If the event depicted actually happened, there would have been some remains fm the fire or explosion, if nothing more than charred ground. Case listed as Other, psychological causes rather than hoax, since the witness is convinced that obj was actually there.

Please send me a copy of the Standard Air Force questionnaire regarding sightings of flying saucers. Also send me the more detailed questionnaire, Form A and Form B, comprising 10 pages of questions. I am requesting these questionnaires because of the fact that, on June 21, 1958, that I saw a saucer-shaped object. Below you will find some of the information on that sighting.

Date: 10/21/58.

Time of sighting: 16:50 - 17:00.

Size: height: 10'; width: 20'.

Shape: elliptical.

Composition: two metal "plate" placed together and joined to each other by a ring around the center of the cap. The cap appeared to be made of aluminum or a substance greatly resembling aluminum.

Sound: faint, then none.

Altitude: 1 mile, gradually dropping to 1/2 mile.

Direction of travel: southeast to northwest.

Movement pattern: straight line, except for change in altitude accomplished by a few intermittent rapid jerks and dips.

Color: silver.

Sound: none, that is, until it exploded.

Length of time in sight: 10 minutes.

Length of time in sound: 10 minutes (please turn over)

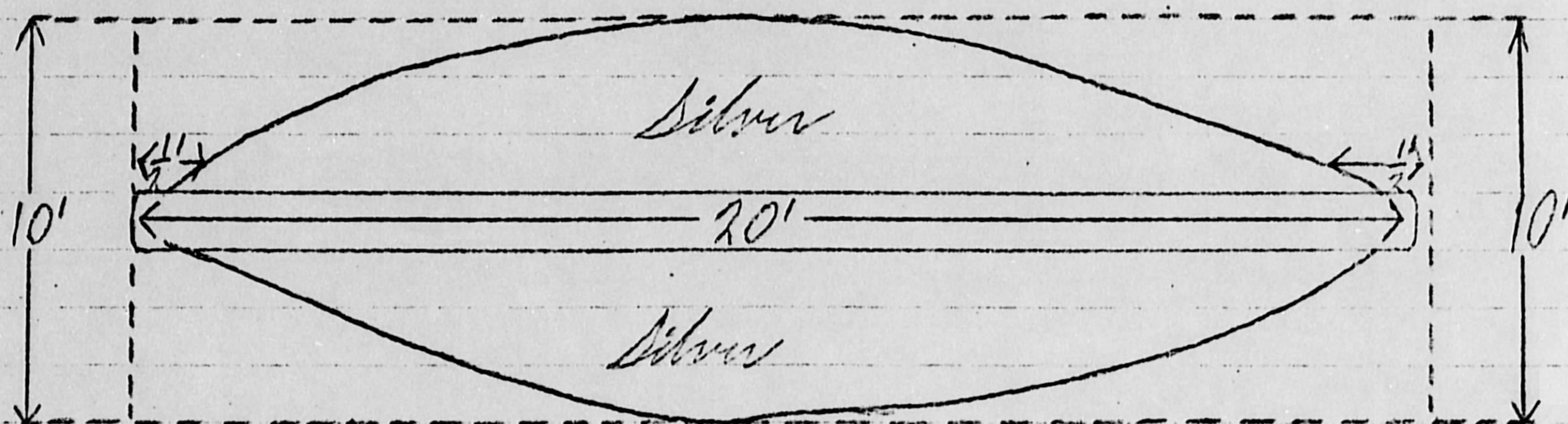

Remarks: I saw the saucer 3 miles from Echo Lake (1 mile from Moss Lake). The saucer was first sighted off in the distance as a minute object, and quickly in fact, very quickly, the object then became more distinct. I was standing on a road at the time. The object came directly up to within 50 feet of me at an altitude of 1 mile. Then, suddenly, it started to attempt a landing, which it never did accomplish. It made nearly 1 attempt to land in the field south-east of me at a distance of 300 feet. On this last attempt, it succeeded in getting to within 12 inches from the ground, a ploughful fall. Then it did it stopped its motion and remained motionless for some time. It just got there, leaving a great, white, circular mark, that it could not get out in. It stayed motionless for nearly 1 minute. In the next on my sight, it was in the air. In the time interval, a red, orange, color, started to appear on me and if the saucer and, this red color moved along the saucer until it reached the other end. Then the whole saucer was glowing red, suddenly a firing sound was heard, after which the saucer exploded. I must confess that I ran from the spot when the explosion occurred. I have told many men for miles around of the saucer but nobody will attempt to believe me.
