AND HELD AT ARM'S LENGTH; OBJECT WAS IN VERTICAL POSITION; A(3) COLOR

CHANGED FROM REDDISH-ORANGE TO WHITE; A(7) SMOKE APPEARED TO BE COMING

OUT OF TOP OF OBJECT; B(2) 25 TO 30 DEGREES ABOVE HORIZON; B(3)

OBJECT WAS STATIONARY; AIRCRAFT FLEW INTO, AND OBJECT WAS OBSCURED

BY, OVERCAST; B(4) OBJECT REMAINED STATIONARY; B(6) FIVE TO TEN

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MINUTES; C(2) BINOCULARS WERE USED, HOWEVER, MAGNIFICATION POWER

UNKNOWN. OBJECT WAS BELIEVDD TO BE CLOUD FORMATION BY SOME OF THE
