FIRST SIGHTING 36 DEGREES 13N - 46 DEGREES 13E; SECOND SIGHTING 55 DEGREES 58N - 45 DEGREES 52N. FIRST SIGHTING 1745 LOCAL TIME, 25 KILOMETERS SOUTH OF SAQUIZZ - ZENITH TO HORIZON, HEADING ON HORIZON ABOUT 80 DEGREES.

LEFT TRAIL FROM TIME OF OBSERVATION FOR FORTY-FIVE SECONDS. THREE TIMES BRIGHTER THAN STARS EMITTING WHITE LIGHT. OBSERVED AGAIN 1915 LOCAL, SAME ROAD, 50 KILOMETERS SOUTH SAQUIZZ. SAME HEADING, LIGHT INTENSITY LESS THAN BEFORE, ZENITH TO HORIZON, WHITE TRAIL, VISIBLE FOR FORTY-FIVE SECONDS. WEATHER CLEAR.
