SIGHTING OF AN UFO BY MR. [REDACTED], AUSTIN,
TEXAS, WAS ACCOMPLISHED IAW AFR 200-2. MR WALLACE OBSERVED A
SINGLE BLINKING LIGHT AT 2030 HRS ON 8 MAY 59 ABOUT 8 MILES NE OF
AUSTIN. THE LIGHT RAN NE TO SE AND WAS OBSERVED FOR APPROXIMATELY
45 SECONDS. AT THAT TIME, A B-52 WAS APPROACHING THIS FROM NE AUSTIN.
SINCE MR WALLACE WAS UNABLE TO DISCERN ANY SHAPE OR SIZE, ACCORD-
ING TO PARA 2 SECTION 2 AFR 200-2, THIS REPORT OF AN INDICATION OF
AN AIRCRAFT WAS NOT REPORTED BECAUSE IT DID NOT FALL WITHIN THE
DEFINITION OF AN UFO.
