THIS PERSON STATED HE HAD BEEN CONNECTED WITH AIRCRAFT FOR THIRTY YEARS AND HAD NEVER SEEN ANYTHING LIKE THE OBJECT. HE DESCRIBED OBJECT AS ROCKET WITH FINS TRAVELING AT JET SPEED AND AT TIMES WOULD JUMP UP AND DOWN. OBJECT TRAVELED HORIZONTAL AND THEN PERPENDICULAR. OBJECT EMITTED A ROAR AND ALSO EMITTED FIRE. OBJECT WAS FAIRLY HIGH AND TRAVELED IN A NORTHWEST DIRECTION. THIRD ANONYMOUS PERSON WAS MALE WHO GAVE [REDACTED] MACON, AS ADDRESS. THIS PERSON STATED OBJECT SHAPED LIKE ROCKET WITH FINS AND APPEARED TO BE FALLING AT TIMES. OBJECT ACTED CRAZILY. SIGHTING AT FORSYTH, GA., MADE AT APPROXIMATELY 162400Z AUG 59 BY NIGHT [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] BOTH PROVIDED SUBSTANTIALLY THE SAME INFORMATION. OBJECT APPEARED TO BE SIZE OF MALE HUMAN HEAD, ROUND IN SHAPE WITH TIP AT BOTTOM. BOTTOM PORTION APPEARED ORANGE IN COLOR. TOP PORTION APPEARED SILVER IN COLOR. ONLY ONE OBJECT SIGHTED. THERE WERE NO DISCERNIBLE FEATURES OR DETAILS. OBJECT MADE NO SOUND. FORSYTH POLICE ALERTED TO POSSIBLE UFO BY MACON POLICE. OBJECT APPEARED FIFTEEN TO TWENTY MILES WEST OF FORSYTH AT APPROXIMATELY THIRTY DEGREES HEIGHT ANGLE FROM OBSERVA-

TION POINT. OBJECT TRAVELED STRAIGHT PATH DIRECTLY AWAY FROM OBSERVERS AND DISAPPEARED BEHIND CLOUD FORMATIONS. OBJECT WAS OBSERVED TWENTY FOUR MINUTES. OBSERVATION WAS GROUND VISUAL. NO OPTICAL AIDS USED. WIND WAS TRAVELING FROM EAST TO WEST AND ESTIMATED TEN TO FIFTEEN MPH. SUN WAS STILL SHINING AND JUST SETTING. PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED NO KNOWN AIRCRAFT WERE IN THE MACON AND FORSYTH AREA AT TIME OF SIGHTINGS. ROBINS AFB HAD NOT RELEASED ANY TYPE
