SUBJECT: UFO Sighting

TO: ATIC, Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio

1. Reference your message AFCIN-4E4G 12-2428-E.
2. Additional information regarding alleged UFO sighting. Objects were not stationary at any time during observance. Surrounding terrain is flat farm land. The objects moved in a straight line at a height of four to fifteen feet in "area B" (see attachment). This puts the objects farther than 75 and 100 feet ahead of observer (point A on attachment). The approximate angular elevation was 10° . The driver was driving at 40 MPH and did not stop until the objects were out of sight.
