and honor of later this letter you or the next president will have
to be brought to the American people, for the truth can be covered
only so long. The truth I am referring to is "flying saucers" I wrote
this letter in two parts the first by own personal witnessing
which helped pulled the trigger for the secret sightings out here
in Calif. which covered most of the state right after my report to
local authorities here and the report sent of defense in Washington
I wrote to. (there were scores of witnesses including local officers
of the FBI, radio station personnel etc.)

I know I heard from a pretty reliable source we
have a base for these down in the desert area. But I feel they are
not all ours, that's why I wrote the second part for I believe it's
the only way that it can be brought to the public for people to know
that we are not hiding anything. I believe that
the public will eventually see these for what they are.

I will not go in details of my own witnessing only
to say they were first sighted July 3rd-- watch repeatedly after that
The morning of July 17th 1:40 two seen in low by the Diamond Watch
Co. near the airport July 18th. There were 125-150 feet in
length and width of about 100-150 feet in height. They were
seen in a line and were seen to be moving. I went to
the airport to try to better view of low flying. (I believe
they are still around I don't know if who came and
saw them, I don't know if they were seen in the July the
day after that of the 15th or later it was seen in various
places in Calif. the night of the 17-18th, they were present in
the night of the 19th and 20th, they were seen in the place
the night of the 21st and 22nd.
