K. CAPTAIN LOSAN LAU, ASSISTANT INTELLIGENCE OFFICER, 401 TAC FTR WG, ENGLAND AFB, LOUISIANA. ACCORDING TO MR. STUBBLEFIELD, THE OBSERVER, SHORTLY AFTER HE RETURNED TO HIS HOUSE FROM CHURCH WITH HIS WIFE AND DAUGHTER AT APPROXIMATELY 3:02 ON 2 SEPTEMBER 1955, HE WAS ATTRACTED BY THE BRIGHT-RED COLOR OF THE OBJECT APPEARING BEHIND SOME TREES AS HE WAS WALKING TOWARD HIS GARAGE FROM THE HOUSE. THE OBJECT MOVED UP AND DOWN RAPIDLY AND FROM A SOUTH-EASTERN TO A NORTH-EASTLY DIRECTION. HAVING BEEN OBSERVED FOR APPROXIMATELY THIRTY SECONDS, THE OBJECT DISAPPEARED BEHIND OTHER TREES AND OBSTRUCTIONS. HE ESTIMATED THE DISTANCE OF THE OBJECT FROM HIMSELF TO BE APPROXIMATELY SIX MILES. THE COLOR AND SITE OF THE OBJECT REMINDED HIM OF A POLICE CAR BEACON EXCEPT

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CAUSED BY JET EXHAUST, AFTERBURNER OR LANDING LIGHTS OF AN AIRCRAFT WHICH HE CLAIMED TO BE FAMILIAR WITH. MR. [REDACTED] HAS BEEN RESIDING IN THIS HOUSE SINCE 1943, AND THIS WAS THE FIRST TIME HE EVER OBSERVED ANY OBJECT OR PHENOMENON SIMILAR TO THE DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HE SAW. LIVING ON A SIX ACRE OF LAND ADJACENT TO TYPICAL LOUISIANA SWAMPY TERRAIN. MR. [REDACTED] DID NOT KNOW OF ANYONE ELSE WHO MIGHT HAVE MADE THE SAME OBSERVATION. MR. [REDACTED] IS A WELL RESPECTED CITIZEN IN THE COMMUNITY. HE APPEARED TO BE A LOGICAL AND SENSIBLE PERSON AND GAVE THE IMPRESSION OF AN INDIVIDUAL WITH AN ALERT MIND. THE INVESTIGATOR HAS REASONABLY ASCERTAINED THAT MR. [REDACTED] DID OBSERVE AN OBJECT OR PHENOMENON ON DATE AND TIME AS REPORTED. HOWEVER, THE INVESTIGATING OFFICER IS OF THE OPINION THAT THE OBJECT COULD HAVE BEEN THE ANTI-COLLISION RED LIGHTS OF A COMMERCIAL AIRCRAFT USUALLY ROTATING ON THE TAIL SECTION OF THE AIRCRAFT. A SUBSEQUENT CHECK WITH THE CONTROL TOWER AND AFD LOCATED ON ENGLAND AFB REVEALED THAT A COMMERCIAL AIRCRAFT EQUIPPED WITH THE AFOREMENTIONED LIGHTS TOOK OFF FROM ISLER FIELD. (31 DEGREES 14 MINUTES NORTH, 92 DEGREES 19 MINUTES WEST) LOUISIANA WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 12 MILES EASTWARD OF ALEXANDRIA AT APPROXIMATELY
