Winds wrong for balloons. Sounds like astronomical sighting but motion contrary to astro bodies. Witnesses reliability as observer doubtful. Previous reports fm same area of similar sighting. Witnesses had 1 1/2 hrs to obtain Bx or camera for picture but didn't do so. Case maintained considered as insufficient data.
