Gave off rays like sun. 2-3 times bigger than star. Another sighted objt seemed to have tail. Another observer repta two objts, one fm SW and one fm NE both appearing to be blue. Another report stated that 4 objts were sighted all stationary. Another reported stated red, green, and yellow objts were sighted.					
11. COMMENTS Sightings were reported observed from several CG stations over a period of about 4 1/2 hrs. One objt is characteristic of rotating beacons on a/c. Some are characteristic of astronomical bodies. LORAN stations at two locations experiencing difficulties, cause unknown. However, these difficulties could have been caused by bad weather, which was probably present at the time.
