No sound heard and object disappeared at 10 deg elevation heading 140 deg true after 15 minutes. No trail or exhaust. Disappeared by fading into horizon into pre-dawn twilight.				11. COMMENTS A check with space track showed that the object was not echo. Slight possibility that the object was a weather balloon, however object did not appear to be gaining altitude. It is possible that a satellite other than echo was the object viewed, however there is no confirming data and the case is carried as insufficient data.

1. SIGHTED UFO AT 131935Z. SHIP POSIT 28 51.5N 131 45.8E. FOUR RELIABLE OBSERVERS SIGHTED ONE ROUND OBJECT BEARING 340 DEG TRUE, POSITION ANGLE 10. OBJECT APPEARED AS BRIGHT WHITE LIGHT, BRIGHTER THAN MOST STARS, AND MOVING WEST TO EAST VERY FAST. OBSERVED FOR APP 15 MINUTES. DISAPPEARED AT 140 DEG TRUE, POSITION ANGLE 10. DARK NIGHT, WEATHER CLEAR, NO MOON. NO AIRCRAFT SIGHTED BEFORE OR AFTER. DID NOT HOLD OBJECT ON RADAR. OBJECT PASSED UNDER NORTH STAR AND APPEARED TO BE QUOTE MUCH BRIGHTER UNQUOTE THAN NORTH STAR. ONE WITNESS STATES OBJECT APPEARED TO MOVE ERRATICALLY. ALL OBSERVERS VIEWED OBJECT THROUGH 22-POWER TELESCOPE OR 20-POWER BINOCULARS.
