3. SIGHTED OBJECT FALLING INTO ATMOSPHERE GIVING GREEN/WHITE BURNING PRESENTATION. THE DIRECTION OF THE OBJECT WAS SOUTH TO NORTH, FORMING AN ANGLE OF 45 DEGREES WITH THE HORIZON. THE TIME INTERVAL WAS ABOUT 2 SECONDS.

ONE TO TWO HOURS LATER A "SEARCH LIGHT" TYPE PHENOMENON APPEARED 030 DEGREES MAGNETIC - STARTING AT 10 DEGREES ABOVE THE HORIZON AND GOING TO INFINITY. THE PHENOMENON REMAINED FOR TWO
