CIVILIAN REPORTING IS IDENTIFIED [REDACTED], AND EMPLOYEE OF THE WELLS CARGO TRUCKING COMPANY, YERRINGTON, NEVADA, PHONE [REDACTED] YERRINGTON. TWO OF THE OTHER FOUR INDIVIDUALS MAKING THIS

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OF SIGHTINGS, NO UNIDENTIFIED OBJECTS SIGHTED. RENO FAA CONTACTED AIRCRAFT. DUE TO LACK OF SUBSTANTIATING REPORTS FROM OTHER LOCALITIES AND PROXIMITY OF MOUNTAIN HIGHWAYS, LIGHTS FROM VEHICULAR TRAVEL REFLECTING UPON CLOUDS, COUPLED WITH INVERSION PHENOMENA, SUGGESTS AN OPTICAL ILLUSION MAY HAVE BEEN CREATED.
