## TWO JET AIRLINERS ENCOUNTER UFO FLYING DISC

### AF Admits Flood of Reports

BULLETIN. The Federal Aviation Agency has just confirmed to NICAP the sighting of a large, round flying object by two jet-airliner crews. Encountered over the Pacific, Sept. 21, the mysterious device swiftly out-distanced the Boeing 707's.



Reports were radioed to FAA towers at Wake and Honolulu by Capt. R.F. Griffin, commanding a British Overseas Airways Corporation plane, and by a Pan American Airways captain. Details indicating a space machine much larger than any now possible on earth were relayed to AF Intelligence.

(On Sept. 25, in a surprising press statement, AF HQ admitted being flooded with reports of "flying objects" near Wake Island.)

Capt. Griffin said the BOAC jet was at 37,000 feet, in a gray, pre-dawn sky, when the UFO appeared.

"Suddenly we saw this bright ring in the sky, about 50 degrees up." The British pilot described the object as round, with sharply outlined edges and a "very clear hole" in the center. "It was traveling in our direction but at far greater speed. There appeared to be reflected light coming down from it. The object went over the horizon in seven minutes."

The confirming Pan-American report also was logged at Honolulu. The FAA has sent for both reports, to be released to NICAP if there are no official objections.

Based on first reports, these points seem evident:

1. The object was not an ICBM missile. Nor was it a satellite re-entering the atmosphere. These appear only as small balls of fire, briefly visible.

2. The reflected light was from the sun, which was an hour below the horizon. The UFO had to be very high to catch its rays.

3. At such a high altitude, the unknown device had to be extremely large (at least several hundred feet in diameter) for its edges and the hole to be so clearly seen by the BOAC crew. The size and description rule out all earthmade rockets, satellites or Echo-type balloons.

The "doughnut" shape the jet crews reported is similar to the future space-base proposed by rocket expert Wernher von Braun--a huge doughnut-shaped ring containing compartments for crews and equipment and rotating to create gravity. At a distance, the connecting framework would be invisible, and from far below the space-base would appear just as Capt. Griffin described the UFO.

More advanced space engineers, experimenting on another planet, could have evolved the same type of space-base. It is possible that what the jet crews saw was such a spacecraft from another world.

AIRCRAFT PA2 VERIFIES SIGHTING OBJECT DOUGHNUT IN APPEARANCE. POSITION  
OF AIRCRAFT AT TIME OF SIGHTING 3455N 15440E AND OBJECT APPEARED ABOUT  
10 DEGREES OVER THE HORIZON AND WELL EAST OF THE AIRCRAFT. AIRCRAFT  
T15182 ADVISES NOTED SAME LIGHT REPORTED BY PA2. WHEN FIRST NOTED IT  
WAS SMALL AND BRIGHT AND AS IT GOT CLOSER IT BECAME BRILLIANT  
LIGHT WITH THE CENTER MISSING SUCH AS A DOUGHNUT MIGHT LOOK AND  
RETAINED THIS APPEARANCE UNTIL LOST ON THE HORIZON. BELIEVE IT  
TO BE AN ELECTRICAL DISTURBANCE OF SOME KIND.
