1. AIR FORCE ENLISTED WEATHER OBSERVER BELIEVED TO BE RELIABLE SIGHTED UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECT AT 111144Z AT ANDERSEN AIR FORCE BASE ON NORTHERN END OF GUAM. ROUND BLUE GREEN OBJECT WAS FIRST SIGHTED DIRECTLY OVERHEAD AND MOVED IN A STRAIGHT NORTHEASTERLY COURSE AT GREAT SPEED CHANGING COLOR TO BLUE GREEN AND DISAPPEARED 20 DEGREES ABOVE HORIZON. DURATION OF SIGHTING WAS 3 SECONDS. NO SOUND. SIZE THAT OF A DIME HELD AT ARMS LENGTH. LIGHT CONDITIONS WERE NIGHT. CLOUD COVER TWO TENTHS. NO KNOWN AIRCRAFT IN AREA.
