Some viewers estimating it at 200' long, was shaped like a ball and had a long tail or trail. Tail appeared to be burning and pieces falling from the object.				11. COMMENTS This object possesses the characteristics outlined for that class of meteor known as a fireball. Re-entries of artificial satellites would produce the same general type display, but no re-entry occurred on this date. Dr. R. M. Tepette, Dominion Astrophysical Observatory reported the object to be a meteor.

There has been an increase in the observation of these enormous large brilliant spheres in 1962, coincidental with the appearance of larger number of saucer and cigar-shaped aerial phenomena. Some curious things about the giant fireballs. Very constant, large size, sometimes emitting flashes of blinding light, low-velocity, sometimes they are seen over very large areas, they make no noise except an occasional thunderous crash, and are never observed to crash.
