1. On 11 April 1963, this District Office received a telephonic notification of a UFO having been sighted by [REDACTED] a schoolboy, [REDACTED] Silver Spring, Maryland, [REDACTED]. A time exposure photograph was allegedly made of the UFO by [REDACTED] and a friend, [REDACTED], Silver Spring, Maryland. [REDACTED] advised this occurred on the night of 11 November 1962 and he has been attempting since then to report it to the proper agency. [REDACTED] described the UFO as a streak of light which traveled horizontally across the sky, turned upward and exploded.
