THE MOST PROBABLE EXPLANATION OF THIS EVENT IS
BELIEVED TO BE THAT OF ENTRY INTO THE ATMOSPHERE AND
SUBSEQUENT DISINTEGRATION OF A METEOR OR METEORITE, AS
INDICATED BY THE NAVSPASUR REPORT. IN SUPPORT OF THIS
ANALYSIS, IT IS NOTED THAT THE RECURRING METEOR STREAM
"VIRGINIDS" APPEARS OVER THE NORTHERN HEMISPHERE DURING THE
PERIOD OF APPROXIMATELY 5-21 MARCH EACH YEAR.
