1. The attached copy of confidential - NO FOREIGN MESSAGE OIN-23 dated 16 Mar 64 is forwarded for information.

During a general discussion on the subject of UFOs with personnel of the 65th Air Division, an attempt was made to locate the "Blue Book," or any other UFO information publication, without success. With a copy of the Blue Book or a similar publication it is believed that Det 3 could satisfy most UFO inquiries.
3. The procedures for reporting UFO's were discussed and members of the 65 AD were advised to report subsequent sightings in accordance with AFR 200-2.

UFOS ARE BEING REPORTED BY SAC AIR REFUELING CREWS DURING NIGHT MISSIONS IN THE GOLDEN SPUR AIR REFUELING AREA (NORTHERN SPAIN). CREWS ARE REPORTING SIGHTINGS ASTERN OF THE REFUELING CELL DURING THE WEST TO EAST REFUELING RUN. CREWS ARE REPORTING OCCASIONAL UFO SIGHTINGS MOMENTARILY ON THEIR AIRBORNE RADAR AND VISUAL SIGHTINGS OF WHITE, RED OR GREEN STEADY OR BLINKING LIGHTS. REPORTED TACTICS OF THE UFOS HAVE VARIED FROM FOLLOWING THE CELL

AT CELL ALTITUDE AND AT DISTANCES VARYING FROM 500 YARDS TO TEN NAUTICAL MILES; MOVING HORIZONTALLY ASTERN TO THE LEFT AND TO THE RIGHT, OR CHANGING ALTITUDES ASTERN OF THE CELL.

PART II. THE FIRST SAC UFO REPORT WAS MADE TO THIS HQ 14 FEB 2100Z FOLLOWED BY SIMILAR REPORTS 19 FEB 0255Z, 26 FEB 2150Z, 8 MARCH 2200Z, 9 MAR 2145Z, 12 MAR 0302Z AND 13 MAR 0329Z.

PART III. TO DATE, 65ADIV ASSETS HAVE BEEN UNABLE TO CONFIRM ANY OF THE UFO SIGHTINGS REPORTED BY THE REFUELING CREWS. SIGHTINGS HAVE NOT CORRELATED WITH KNOWN U.S. OR FOREIGN MILITARY OR COMMERCIAL AIR TRAFFIC. PART IV. REQUEST ANY NIGHT AIR OPERATIONS INFORMATION OF A DOMESTIC OR FOREIGN, MILITARY OR CIVIL NATURE ORIGINATING IN THE BAY OF BISCAY, SOUTHERN FRANCE, PORTUGUESE ATLANTIC AND PORTUGAL WHICH MAY BE CORRELATED TO THE UNKNOWN SIGHTINGS.
