Dear Sir,

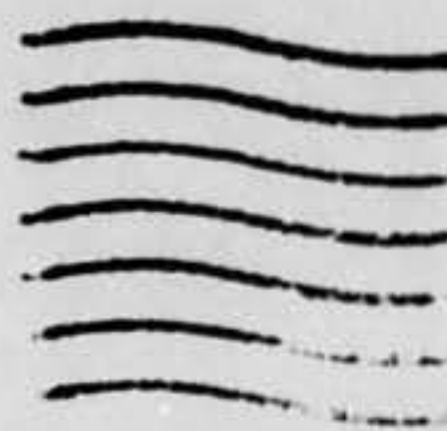
