15. SUMMARY:

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Police Department notified by Mr Connor, McClellan Base Operations, that the Officer of the Day at Mather AFB, Lt Undorf, had received a report of a UFO from [redacted] who stated he had observed an object traveling from North to South which appeared to be the shape of a star. Object was a bright white in color, traveling in a straight path, lower than the stars, larger than a star, with an exhaust trail $\frac{1}{4}$ inch to the rear. Object made no sound and faded out in approximately 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ minutes at about 4 O'clock. Object sighted at 1550 Zulu time, 30 May 64. Stated he was going to keep watching as he felt it would pass over again in about 88 minutes.
