1. THREE (3) DULL WHITE LIGHTS, SIZE ABOUT ONE-FOURTH THE SIZE OF THE MOON, NO SOUND.

2. FAMILY WAS OUTSIDE IN BACKYARD SHOWING THE BIG DIPPER TO CHILDREN WHEN THE HUSBAND SPOTTED THE LIGHTS. LIGHTS WERE DIRECTLY OVERHEAD AT ABOUT 2000 TO 3000 FEET. THE LIGHTS WERE GOING FROM SOUTH TO NORTH IN RELATIVELY LEVEL FLIGHT. MOVING ABOUT THE SPEED OF A RECIPROCATING AIRCRAFT. WAS OBSERVED FOR TWO (2) MINUTES. DISAPPEARED BEHIND A TALL
