SIGHTING: (Interviewed by Subcommittee member, Mr. Donald Meyers)

(Donald Meyer's notes are as follows): -"The observation took place between eight in the evening to three or four o'clock in the morning. A total of ten people saw the objects, although apparently not all at the same time. A big ship appeared. First noted at eight o'clock. Soon after the ship appeared, several cargo planes appeared from Bedford (Hanscom AFB) and circled near the "mother ship" (her words). Then a jet appeared and circled around the mother ship. When the jet went under the ship, the jet lit up brightly. (Lights from ship on jet). After this, the airplanes went away. The big ship came in from the South-West and came close to the ground....four smaller ships came out. One went to the North and disappeared. One hung over the mother ship for awhile and then went South-East and hung there. The other two went to the South-East and hung there for awhile and then began a slow swing from the East to the South and then back to the East. This kept up for most of the observation period. The mother ship moved slowly over the horizon and disappeared. (Don't know direction). At approximately 4:00 AM the small ship from the South-West moved toward the two in the East and came down where the mother ship was last seen. The one in the North did not come back. The mother ship had a red pulsating light on the bottom. (Had a red and white light on each end also which blinked alternately). The small ships had a single pulsating light on the bottom."

Additional information is as follows: The objects were quite large to the eye. The larger UFO had an apparent size of a dollar bill held at arm's length. The 4 smaller UFOs were compared to the size of a silver dollar held at arm's length.

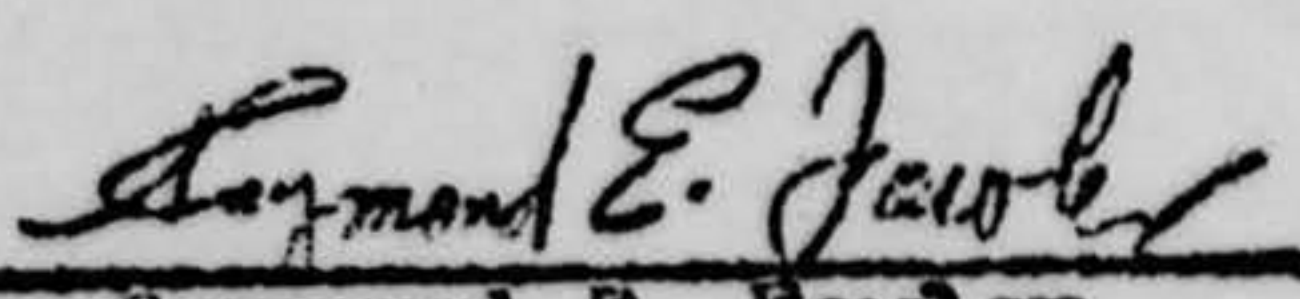
