Two sightings, one prior to 0300Z other after 0300Z. One object disappeared in North, other in flight from SE to NW. Both disappeared instantly. Straight flight. 3d report: Ball shaped blue object appearing as fireworks. White smoke trail. Moving from East to West in arc climbing and then descending. COMMENTS: Probable meteor observation. Sheriff's report indicated a two second observation. Other witnesses probably overestimated the duration, case considered as same object observed by three observers. 2nd report includes additional meteor observation prior to the second meteor.
