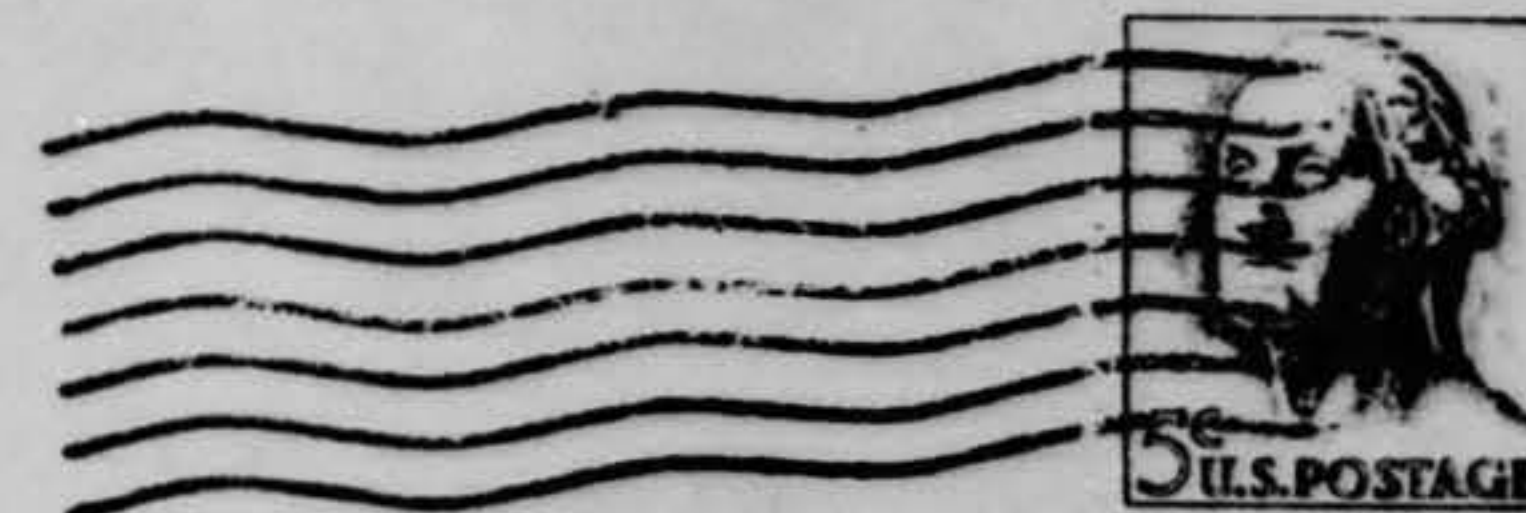
Last night I noticed a peculiar occurrence and since you deal with this kind of work I was hoping you might be able to provide an explanation as to exactly what it was I saw.

I had just arrived home from orchestra practice and stopped to look up at the sky. It was a clear, starlit night without any noticeable cloud cover. As I paused to watch the sky for a moment there was suddenly a rather bright green flash almost directly overhead. I realized immediately that it wasn't a meteor because of its high angle of attack, high altitude with large size, and relatively low speed. The possibility of an airplane is negated by its size and altitude.

This lasted only a few seconds and I was alone, but I would appreciate hearing from you.

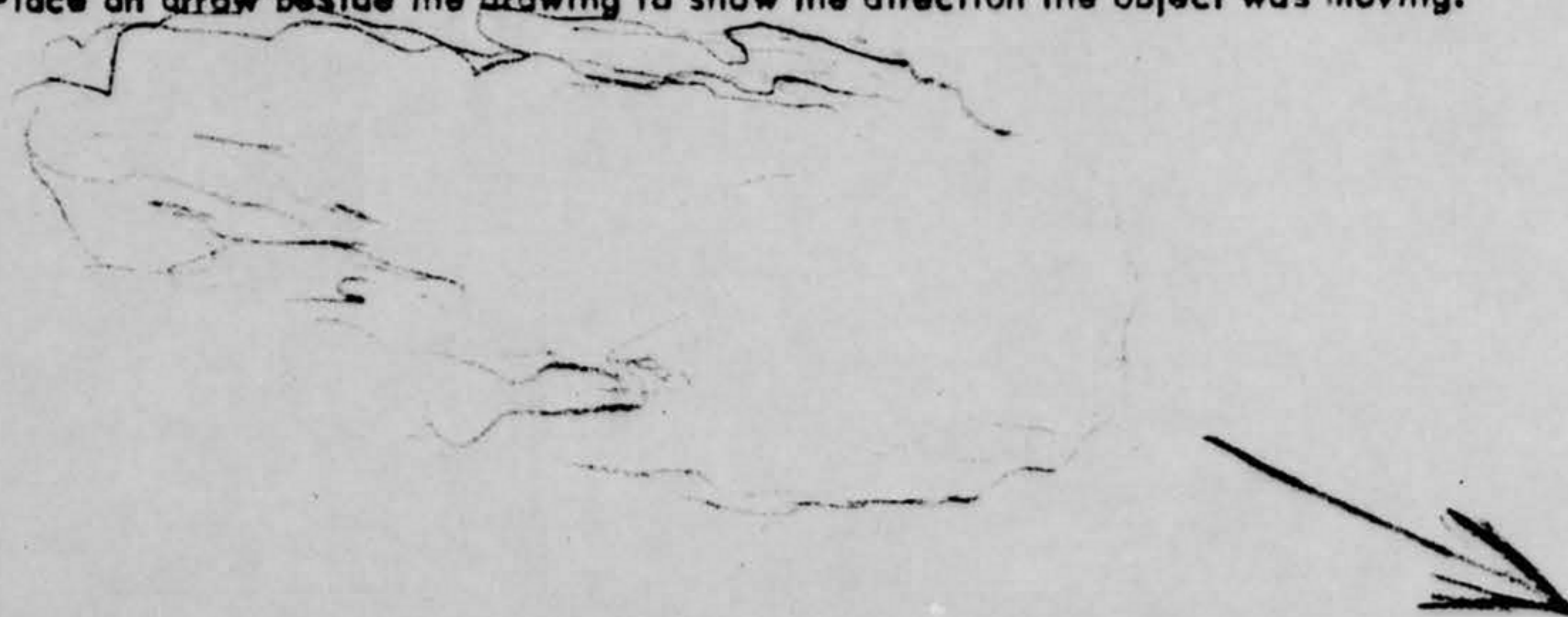
