My daughter saw an object hovering over
the trees in our Frick woods, about 1,000
feet from the spot where she and her friend
were playing. It was dusk, right before
our dinner time, and it had ended within
the next two weeks. The object was the
flat round kind, red at the bottom, yellow
in the middle and black at the top. It
had two eyes (.) and one on the top,
also. This is according to her description.

I am not going into too much more detail, because I understand you people never answer these reports, nor recognise them, except to deny their authenticity. However, just for the record, I am reporting it, and I will be mighty surprised if I hear even a word recognition from this agency (of the people?).

I have, of course, reported it to HICAP and, for what it is worth, they and you have the information.

Incidentally, my daughter has had sleepless nights because of this and has expressed fear of it and has repeated her story, without contradiction, unprompted, two other times since the original breathless report she gave us that night. She is 6 years old and it can easily be said it is all a figment of her imagination.
