stations?

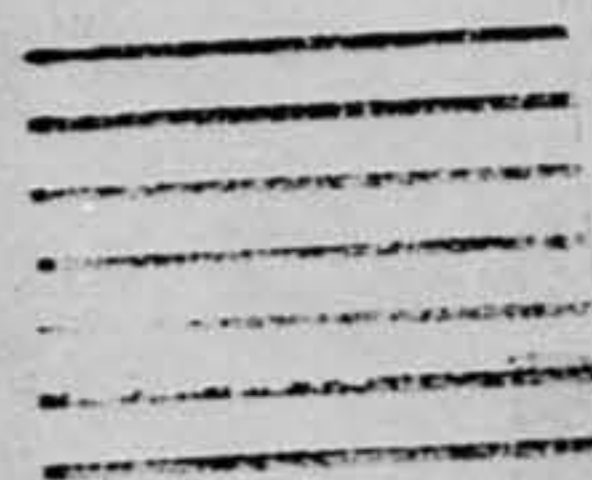
