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1. MERINT F/V SWIFT WC7294 SIGHTED UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS. TWO OBJECTS APPROX 150 FEET LONG, CYLINDRICAL SHAPE, DULL METALIC COLOR, WITH BLOW TORCH LOOKING EYHAUST AND DENCE BLACK SMOKE TRAIL. OBJECTS FLYING SOUTH EAST LOW ON THE HORIZON IN A NOSE UP ATTITUDE, FLYING HORIZONTALY AT HIGH RATE OF SPEED AND THEN TURNING WEST STRAIGHT UP AND DISSAPEARED FROM SIGHT IN A LARGE PUFF OF SMOKE/ OBJECTS, WERE VERY LARGE AND LEFT A RED AND BLACK TRAIL AGAINST SKY.

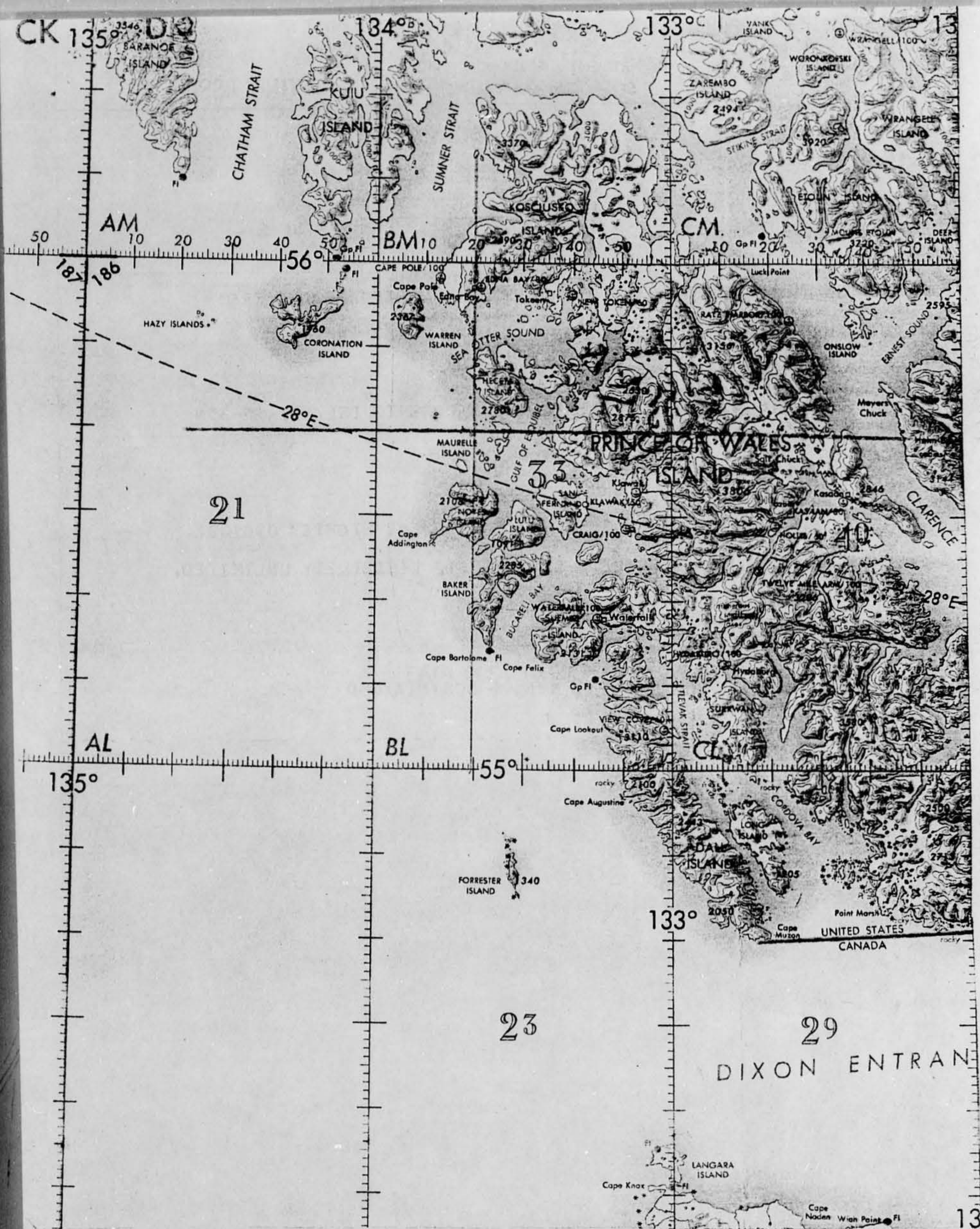
