Came from SE, turned North and disappeared into the distance. Speed estimated at 60 mph. Altitude estimated at 3,000 ft. Duration 3 minutes possible 5 minutes. Inversions at 1,000 and 7,000 ft. Slow speed, large red light. Possible experimental type a/c or infra red photo type plane from description. More likely experiminental since the red glow was reported as <u>above</u> the silver triangle (A/C).
