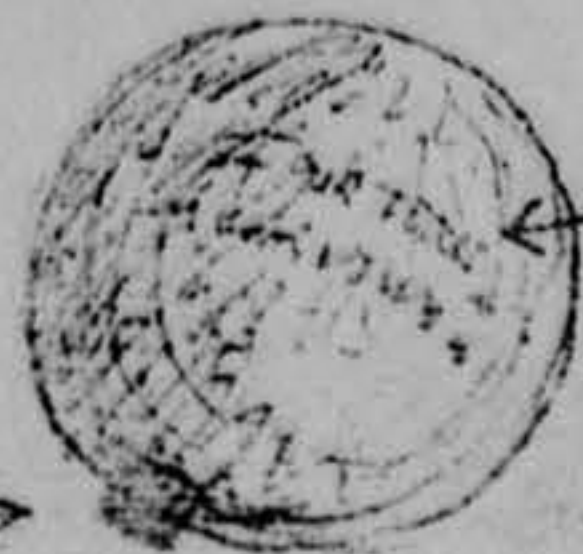

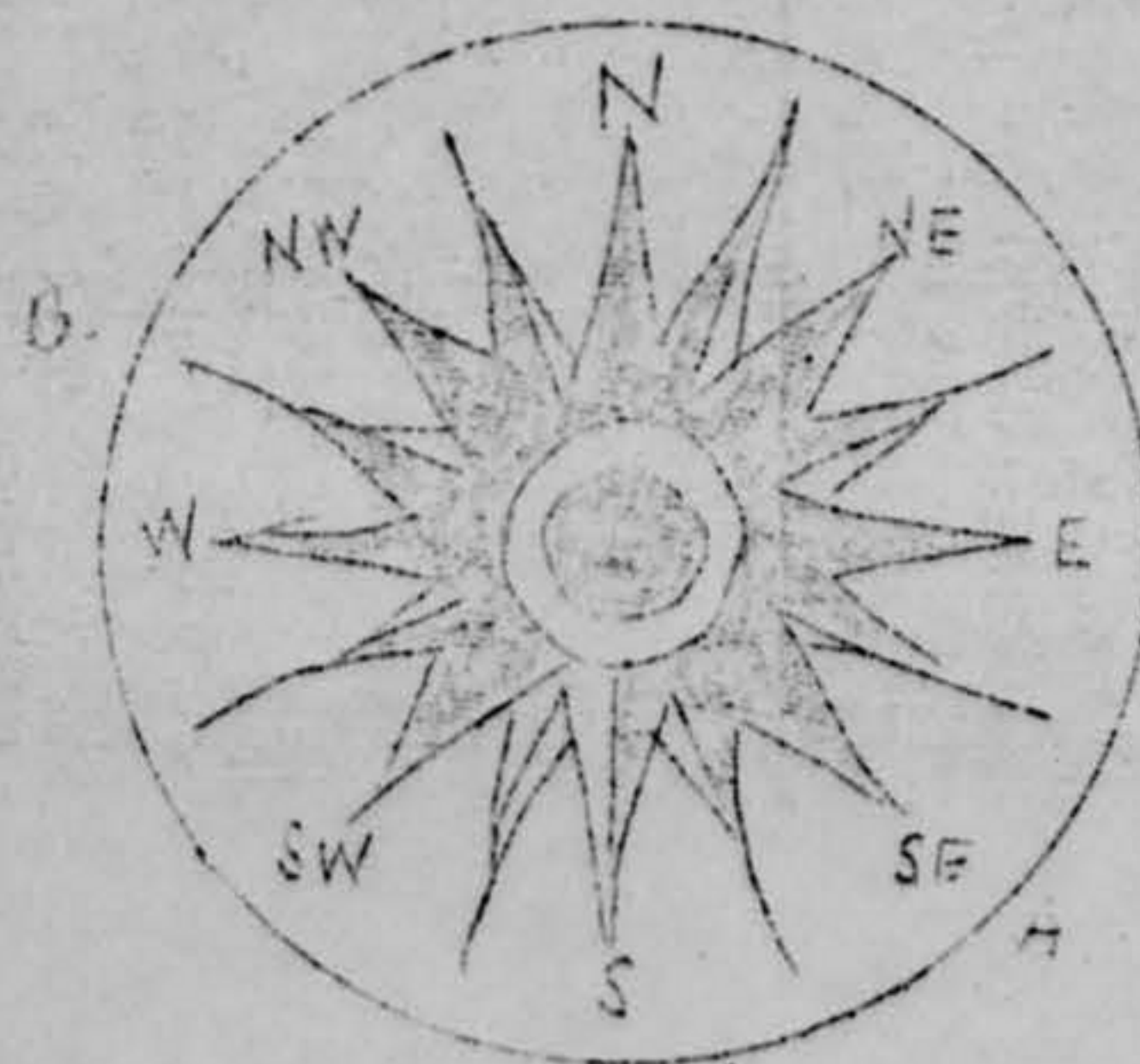
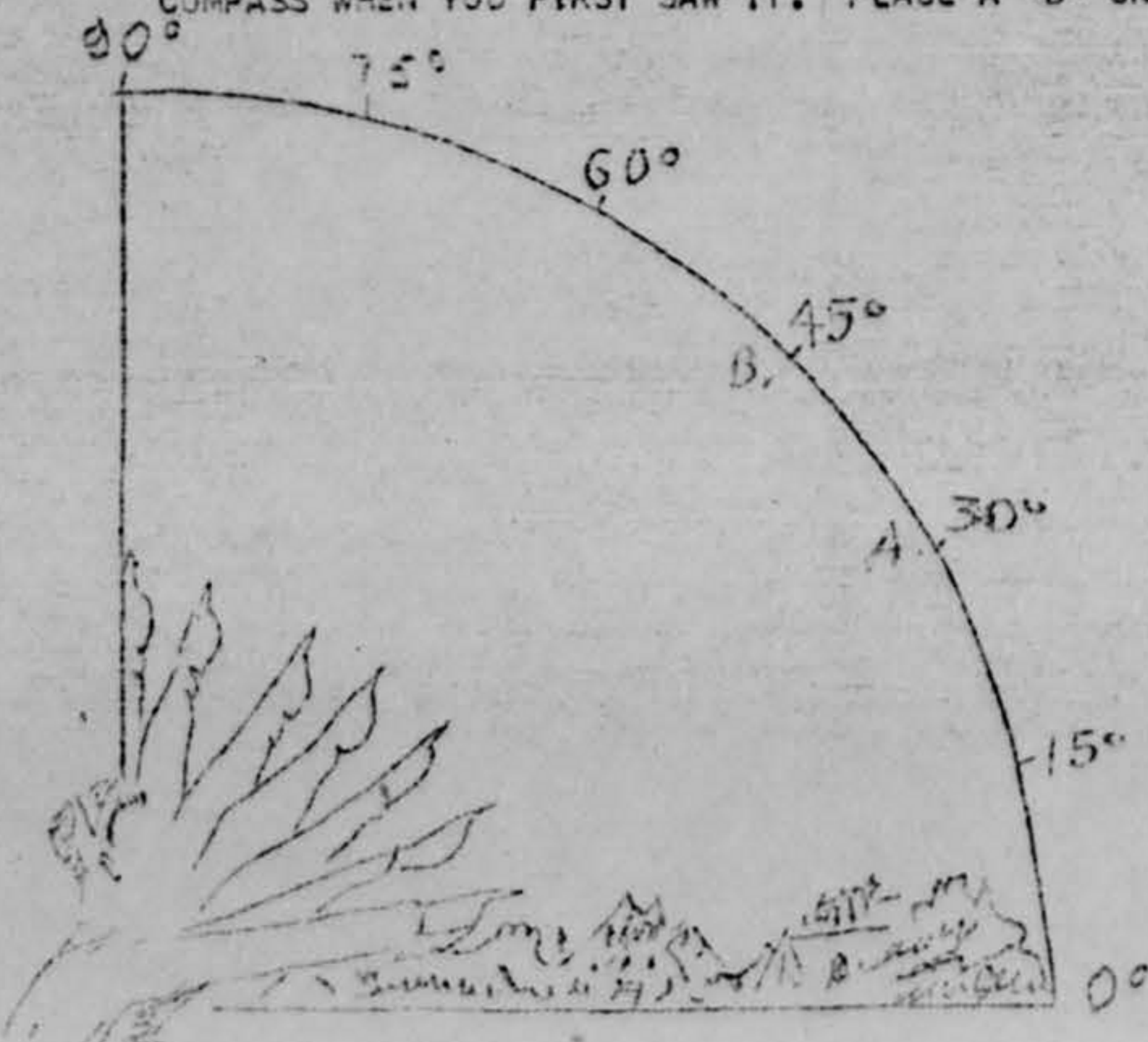

I have been traditionally skeptical of UFO reports, had no intentions of looking for one, or ever hoped to see anything strange. I was it that moment simply out for a walk.

I assumed it was a balloon, possibly weather balloon from Municipal Airport in Bemidji, as it came with the wind (a strong SE 40-50 mph wind from the SE), never showed any sign of self propulsion, except for the mysterious fact that it settled on the ground momentarily, then rose slightly, steeply, and went off with the wind again. I fully intended to run over, pick it up, but when it rose, I then began to think it might not be a balloon. The incident has stirred up all sorts of queries and curiosity in the Chambrak, Minn., area. (My version in file)
