SUBJECT: Extract from Staff Duty Officer's Report

The following was extracted from the SDD Staff Duty Officer's Report for the period 1630 1 Oct 65 to 0600 2 Oct 65.

"UFO - Sonar reported sighting by radar. Declined to give name and terminated call. 1915 hrs. Sighted earlier in the day.

[REDACTED] Manhattan Place, L. A., age 35, student, phone [REDACTED].
[REDACTED] a. Appeared as star moving rapidly NW. 1930 hrs, 1 Oct. Observed for 15 minutes. Reported thin, translucent, not straight line - appeared to travel in an arc. Apparently emitting light. 'Looked like star moving very fast - twinkling. Moving faster than anything I ever saw.' This did not appear to be a prank on the Ray's part."

"UFO - [REDACTED] South San Gabriel, phone ext [REDACTED].
Reported three objects appeared to be [REDACTED] ship. All uncovering all over his desk for more than an hour, from about 0500 until time of call at 2300. Observer reported watching objects with binoculars, however description was vague - mostly relating to changing colors. He reported hearing [REDACTED] sound at one time. A second man was there, and reportedly also saw the objects. Call lasted several minutes, during which caller described comings and goings of the objects, colors, etc. During call, second man came in to say he had sighted objects again. Caller sounded excited during call."
