The following was extracted from the SSO Staff Duty Officer's Report for the period 1630 1 Oct 65 to 0800 2 Oct 65:

" UFO - Woman reported sighting by husband. Declined to give name and terminated call. 1910 hrs. Sighted earlier in the day.

[REDACTED] Manhattan Place, L. A., age 15; student, phone nr: [REDACTED] a. Appeared as star moving rapidly NNE. 1930 hrs, 1 Oct. Observed for '5 minutes.' Inspected thru binoculars. Path not straight line - appeared to travel in an arc. Apparently extreme altitude. 'Looked like star moving very fast - twinkling. Moving faster than anything I ever saw.' This did not appear to be a prank on the boy's part."

" UFO - [REDACTED], South San Gabriel, phone nr: [REDACTED] Reported three objects: one appeared to be 'mother' ship. All maneuvering all over his area for more than an hour, from about 2050 until time of call at 2900. Observer reported watching objects with binoculars, however description was vague - mostly relating to changing colors. He reported having heard a 'humming' sound at one time. A second man was there, and reportedly also saw the objects. Call lasted several minutes, during which caller described comings and goings of the objects, colors, etc. During call, second man came in to say he had sighted objects again. Caller sounded excited during call."
