It is possible that observer saw one and/or both of these aircraft with sunlight reflecting on it. However, carried as insufficient data for evaluation, since observer did not return 164.

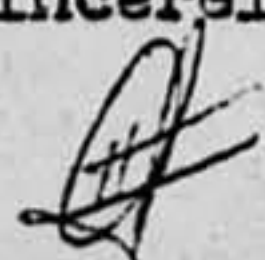
