Object traveled NE toward Harlingen at a high rate of speed. On 3 Sept. 66 another member of the family observed an object that caused the TV to go on the blank. The house was lit up with eerie red and yellow light. On 5 Sept. 66 another member of the family observed a small person dressed in form fitting white enter into the dark bedroom. Several minutes a bar of light appeared from the room.

A. OBJECT SITED WAS SHAPED LIKE AN UPSIDE DOWN CUP ON FIRST
OBSERVATION ON 6 AUG 1966; SAME SHAPE WITH SAUCER BELOW ON
SECOND SITING, 3 SEP 66.

B. FIRST SITING ARRIVAL NOT OBSERVED. OBJECT WAS DARK WHEN
NOTICED AT 2000Z WITHOUT COLOR AND WITHOUT LIGHTS. DURING
SEVERAL MINUTES OBSERVATION ONE SQUARE YELLOW LIGHT APPEARED

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LIKE A DOOR OPENING. THREE CHILDREN AGES 6 TO 9 STATED A
SMALL PERSON APPEARED IN THE SQUARE OF LIGHT; THEN "DOOR" WAS
CLOSED. THE PERSON WAS APPROXIMATELY 3 TO 4 FT TALL AND
DRESSED IN BLACK BUT CLOTHING REFLECTED YELLOW OR GOLD COLOR
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IN THE "DOOR" LIGHT. OBJECT HOVERED ABOUT 15 FT ABOVE GROUND
NEAR AN ORANGE TREE APPROXIMATELY 35 FT FROM THE HOUSE BUT DID
NOT LAND. ON DEPARTURE, A LOW HUMMING SOUND WAS HEARD. OBJECT
TRAVELED NORTHEAST TOWARD HARLINGEN AT HIGH RATE OF CLIMB BUT
"AVERAGE" SPEED. AT SECOND SITING, 3 SEP 1966, 2000-2100Z,
AN 18 YEAR OLD GIRL WITH A FRIEND OBSERVED OBJECT. TELEVISION
SNOWED, THEN WENT OUT. HOUSE WAS LIT UP WITH EERIE RED AND
YELLOW LIGHT WHICH SEEMED TO BE CIRCLING OR TWIRLING. ON LOOKING
OUTSIDE, OBJECT WAS NOTICED HOVERING IN SAME SPOT AS AT FIRST
SITING NEAR THE SAME ORANGE TREE ABOUT 15 FT ABOVE GROUND.
OBJECT APPEARED TO BE COVERED WITH LIGHT. DEPARTURE DIRECTION
AND SPEED UNKNOWN.

C. THE ABOVE SITINGS WERE REPORTED TO KELLY AFB ON 6 SEP
1966 BY MR. [REDACTED] DRIVE, HARLINGEN,
TEXAS. HOME PHONE [REDACTED] BUSINESS PHONE [REDACTED]

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AREA CODE 512. FIRST SITING OBSERVED BY HIS THREE SMALL CHILDREN: SECOND SITING BY HIS 18 YEAR OLD DAUGHTER WHILE REST OF FAMILY WAS AWAY. HOUSE IS LOCATED IN SOUTHWEST PART OF HARLINGEN, FAIRLY ISOLATED. NEAREST NEIGHBOR ABOUT 400 FT AWAY. OBJECT APPEARED IN YARD ON NORTHEAST SIDE OF THE HOUSE. INCIDENTS PAGE 3 RUWGNH4646 UNCLAS WERE NOT DISCUSSED WITH NEIGHBORS.

D. MR. [REDACTED] BELIEVES THAT OBJECT WAS NEAR ON 8 AUG 1966 AT 2000-2100Z BECAUSE OF THE OCCURRENCE OF BRIGHT FLASH OF LIGHT.

E. ON 5 SEP 1966, MR. [REDACTED] WAS PROPPED UP IN BED. THROUGH HIS DOOR AND ACROSS A HALL HE COULD SEE DARK DOORWAY LEADING TO SON'S BEDROOM. HE SAW A SMALL PERSON, ABOUT 3 1/2 TO 4 FT HIGH, DRESSED IN FORM FITTING WHITE, ENTER INTO THE DARK BEDROOM. MR. [REDACTED] ASSUMED IT WAS HIS SMALL DAUGHTER GOING IN TO TALK TO HER MOTHER WHO WAS IN THE ROOM WITH HIS SONS. APPROXIMATELY 7 OR 10 MINUTES LATER A BAR OF LIGHT APPEARED AND SEEMED TO CRUMBLE. HE RUSHED TO THE ROOM AND TURNED ON THE LIGHT AND SAW HIS WIFE AND BOYS. THEY HAD ALSO SEEN THE BAR OF LIGHT. HE STATED HE DID NOT SEE THE PERSON IN WHITE LEAVE AND

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HIS WIFE STATED THE DAUGHTER HAD NOT BEEN IN THE ROOM AT ANY TIME.

F. WEATHER ON 3 SEP 1966 IN HARLINGEN AREA AT TIME OF

INCIDENT WAS CLEAR 15 86/74/1314/994 WITH UNSTABLE AIR FROM

GROUND TO 2500 FT. ON 5 SEP 1966- SCATTERED 15 82/73/1412/988

UNSTABLE TO 1500 AND TEMPERATURE INVERSION AT 3000.

G. ACW RADAR LOGS DO NOT RECORD ANY UFO TYPE PHENOMENA.

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H. MR. [REDACTED] STATED WHEN QUESTIONED THAT THERE WAS NO

PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OF THE OBJECT ON THE GROUND BELOW THE HOVER

SITE. THE ORANGE TREE WAS NOT DAMAGED EXCEPT THAT THREE OF FOUR

GREEN ORANGES WERE FOUND ON THE GROUND THE NEXT MORNING. THERE

WAS NO PHYSICAL EVIDENCE TO SUBSTANTIATE THAT THE SMALL PERSON

OBSERVED BY MR. [REDACTED] WAS IN THE HOUSE.
