Pilot stated object was in view for 2 -3 seconds and appeared to burn out at an altitude of 10,000'.

EST 100,000 FEET X PILOT OF SARATOGA F4B A/C WAS AT 20,000 FT. ON THE
245 DEGREE RADIAL 61 MILES FROM CAIVANO TACAN. THE UFO WAS INITIALLY
SIGHTED WEST OF CAIVANO AT AN ESTIMATED ALTITUDE OF 100,000 FEET IN A
45 DEGREE DIVE ANGLE. THE UFO WAS DESCRIBED BY THE PILOT AND RIO AS A
RED FIRE BALL WITH A BLUE-GREEN TAIL. IT FIRST APPEARED TO BE THE
SIZE OF A PIN POINT AND GREW TO BE ABOUT HALF THE SIZE OF THE MOON
(AS IT WOULD APPEAR IN THE SKY AT FULL MOON). IT APPEARED FOR 2-3
SECONDS AND IMPACTED IN WATER, TO THE WEST OF THE LAND MASS OUTSIDE ROME
(APPROX 30-50 MILES SOUTH OF ROME). UFO APPEARED TO BURN OUT AT ALT
10,000 FEET.
