The light fluttered up and then dropped straight down, then rose up again- hovered in one area but seemed to be wobbling at times. Object appeared to take off and travel toward the west. Since the 6 Oct. sighting Observer has seen as many as 6 or 7 objects on different nights. The observer wanted to stress that she has seen these things almost every night. The observer has seen many objects every night except for one or two cloudy nights. Observers descriptions are very consistent with that of an astronomical observation. The witnesses have seen many objects in the sky since the 6 Oct. 66 sighting.

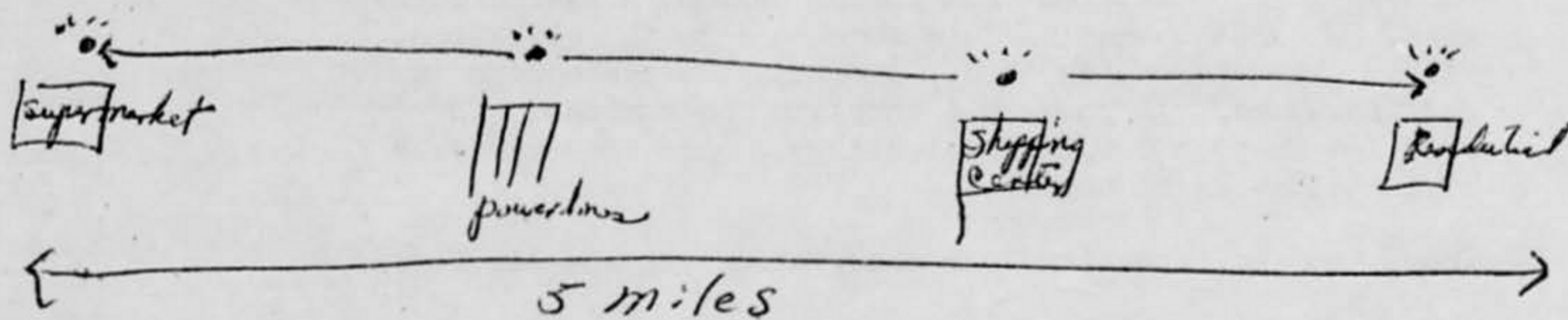

Just one other point that is probably insignificant, but in travelling from Pittsfield to Dalton we noticed 4 of these ^{flashing} red white + green objects in what appeared to be a line over a distance of perhaps 5 miles



I hope that this information will be of some value to you. These things are some sort of definite craft, that can easily be discerned upon seeing them. They are not airplanes, helicopters ^{are} (too slow) ^{they are} (too silent) not satellites (viewed for hours at a time) not weather balloons (Nov 6th down below a low ceiling of haze) Not planets or stars, (altitude too low for that) not weather inversion, (move around too much) I am sure that planes from Westover AFBASE could easily spot them. They are there about every night.

about fifteen minutes it rose in the air and then dropped down. It fluttered and yawed like a kite in the wind, and could change direction instantly. Four adults watched this for over an hour from my kitchen window.

A. It was not a satellite

1. its altitude was too low
2. it would have orbited the earth in the time that we watched it.

3. it was not in a stable pattern

B. It was not a helicopter or plane

1. It was absolutely silent. at that altitude it would have been heard

C. It was not a planet or star.

1. It was too low and too erratic
2. It was definitely a large flashing beacon

D. It was not weather inversion or marsh gas

1. Again it was too low + too clearly viewed.

On other nights we spotted a craft that shot in from star altitude, streaked across the sky at airplane altitude and then just stopped and hovered in one spot flashing white red and green.

Dear Major Quintanilla,

This letter is written on notebook paper only in my urgency to reach you on this matter. Please do not let this detract from the information that has prompted me to write.

Every night since October 6th of this year, I have spotted from one to four U.F.O.'s in the Pittsfield, Dalton, Massachusetts area. They appear at 7³⁰ pm, and at 10 pm are still there. There are three adult witnesses to this who spotted them from Pittsfield while I viewed them from Dalton. We checked each other out by phone to verify the sightings.

On October 6th the U.F.O. seemed to be at the altitude of a propeller type plane. It just sat there at first blinking a brilliant red light. Sometimes it blinked red and white, and then after remaining stationary for

Another night one appeared as a yellow
white disk at rather high altitude, and
while this disk sauntered about the
sky, three smaller objects with
red and white lights circled about
at a lower altitude in a most erratic
pattern. ② See note above.

We put a telescope on one on the
night of Oct 7th. This one blinked red
white and green, and seemed to shoot
little jets out of the bottom. Five
(5) more adults left the range of
skeptics that night.

The Air Force has a problem of
great magnitude forced upon it. I
did not believe in these things, but
now that I have seen them no
one can ever tell me that they
do not exist, nor will I accept a
trite explanation for them. You
do have one element in your favor,
we drove by a parking lot at a
large shopping center while this
thing maneuvered about 2000 feet
above it, and just off to one side.
Not one person looked up, and if

asked about it I am sure they would say they didn't see it. I called a neighbor, she glanced out the window I then said she didn't see it. I know she didn't for at that time it dropped out of sight behind tree level, it later rose into view, and the 4 adults at my house clearly viewed it. I watched the man across the street walk into his backyard and not glance up while ~~four~~ of these things flitted about high in the sky over his head.

I do not expect an answer to this letter, but I do want to express my opinion on what I feel is a serious matter. I was absolutely terrified the night of October 6th when I saw something that I had read did not exist. Now that we know that they are there, they do not frighten us to such an extent, but the first reaction to them was shock. I feel sorry for the people who have yet to be surprised by this phenomenon to which not

We went outdoors also. After she watched it for well over an hour she did not want the children or me to stay here alone. My husband was away on a business trip. We saw the UFO

I covered in detail the first sighting on Oct 6th. We still see these things almost every night. They now appear at dark and are still there at 5 AM. I watched one streak in from pinpoint ^{traveling from west to east} star altitude to an airplane altitude in about 20 seconds. It then hovered and blinked white red and green ^{for over 3 hrs}. On Sunday NOV. 6th - it was very hazy here. No stars could be seen. The moon could not be seen. Only a thick foggy cloudiness. One of these top shaped things dropped erratically down below the haze and then hovered for 30 minutes. It was bright fluorescent white - had a blinking red light on top - through binoculars I could make out another blinking red light on the bottom plus flashes of green. My husband, and brother-in-law saw this also. We also watched thru a telescope on other nights, they seem to be spinning as they hover, and drop up and down. My brother-in-law ~~_____~~ saw one that appeared 4" in diameter, brilliant white, disk shaped at about 430 AM, over the house next to his. Comparing the moon to a breakfast plate, this object looked like a grapefruit size. In the early evening they are not as low as they are between 2 AM and 4 AM. A ~~_____~~ Drive
