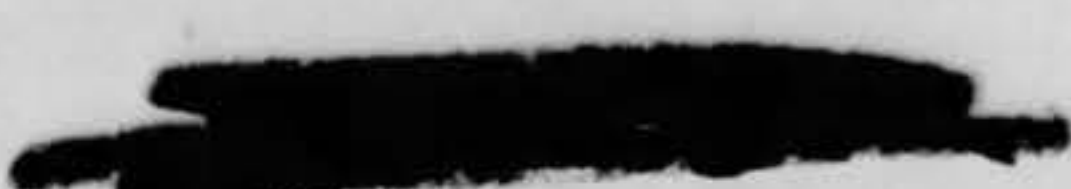

Heavy aircraft traffic in the area. Description is similar to often reported from an aircraft.

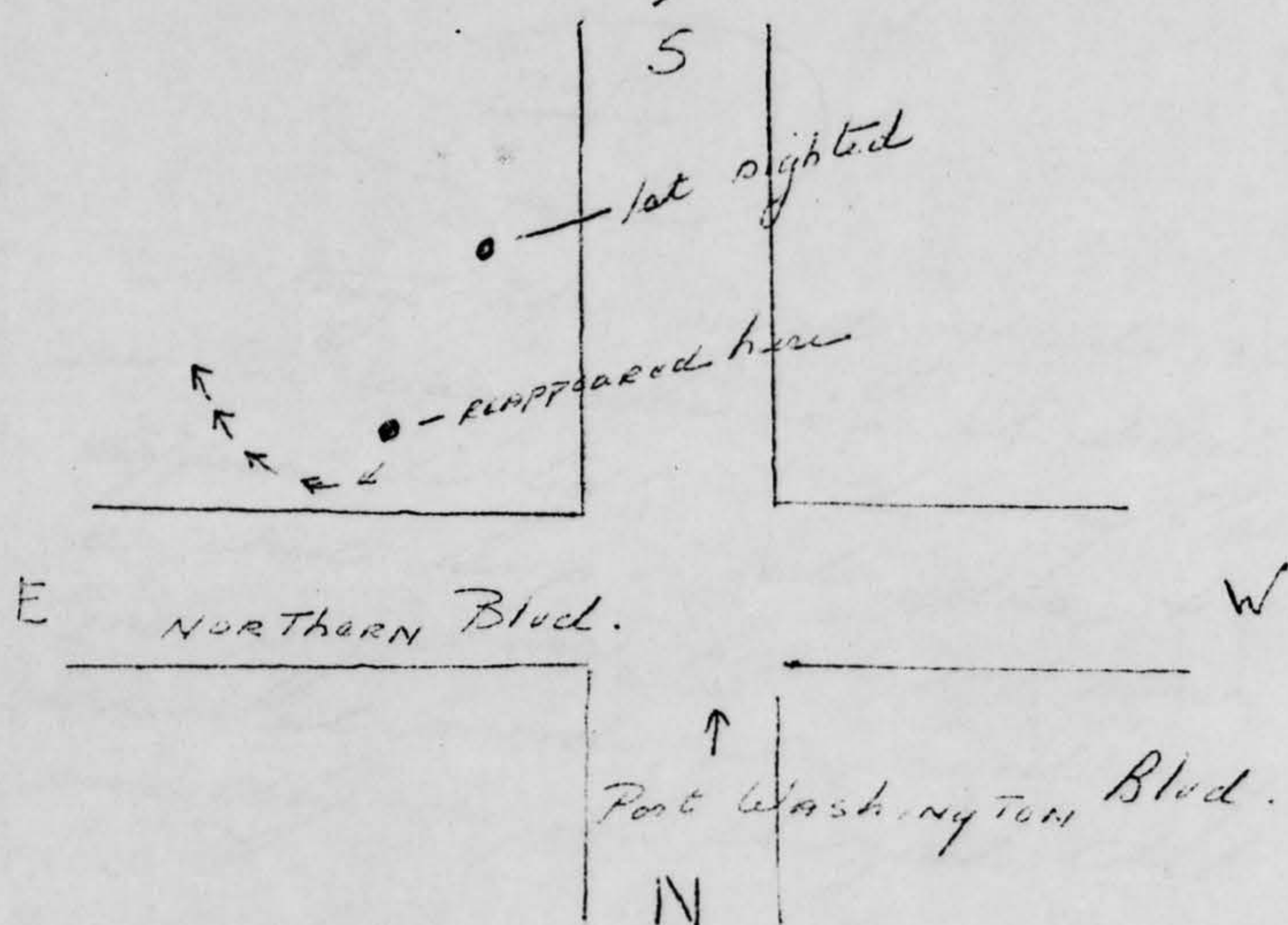

Dear Sir:

At about 7:25 P.M., Thurs day,
Nov. 3rd 1966, I was heading south
on Port Washington Blvd. in Port
Washington. At a point about
200 ft north of the intersection of
Port Washington Blvd & Northern Blvd.
I noticed a stationary glowing object
above some tall elms in a heavily
wooded residential area which backs
up to Northern Blvd. The reason
I noticed this light at all was,
as I have said, there are many
tall trees in the area & normally
there are no lights or houses
visible from the north side of the
boulevard.

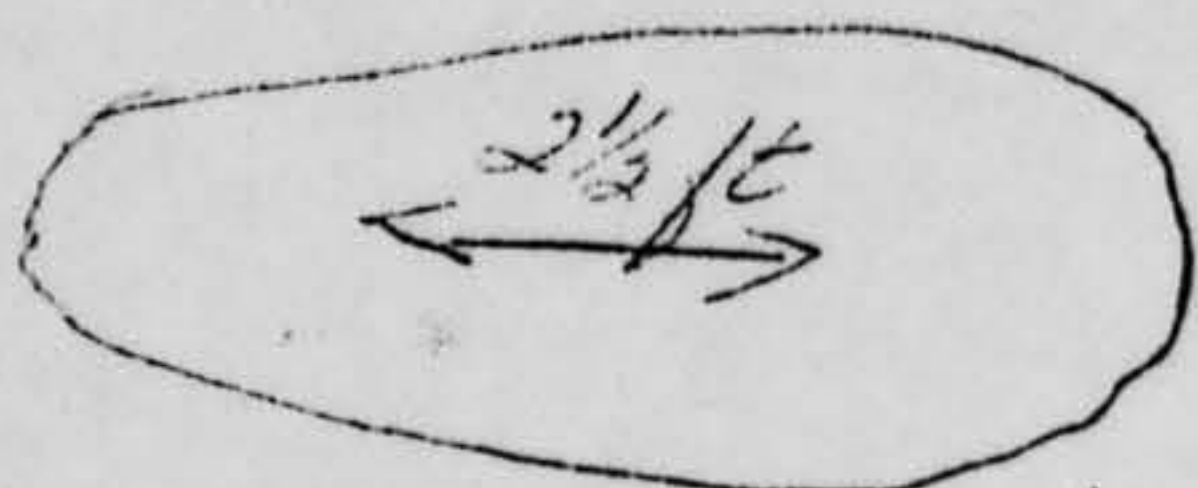
I had to stop at the intersection
 on a red light & at that point
 I lost sight of the object. I looked
 out the side window, which I had
 opened to get a better view, and
 the object reappeared, about 50 ft
 in front of me; and at about a
 height of 4 ft. It moved horizontally
 and vertically in a half circle
 movement heading south east.



The ^{light} changed green: I had to move on. It was several minutes before I was able to retrace my route and could see nothing.

I saw what appeared to be the side of the object. It had a modified egg shape & was about two to two and half feet long.

It looked something like this.



Although the object glowed, its outline was precise, i.e. it didn't diffuse its light in the way that a street lamp or bulb does. I saw no projections, heard no noise & when it moved, it moved very smoothly despite the fact that

it was a very windy night.
