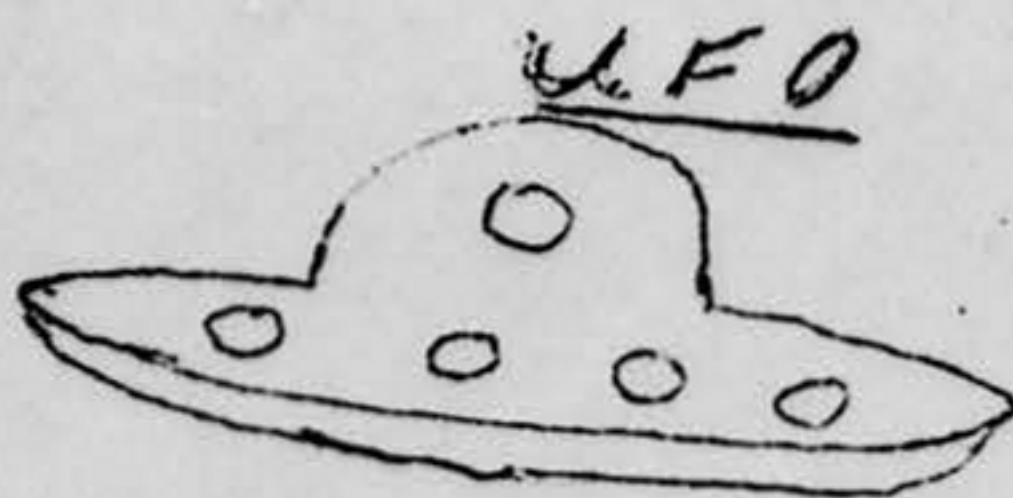
I would like to report a UFO. Three of us saw it. My girlfriend and I saw it through the school window at about 3:45 A. M. My other girlfriend saw it in the afternoon about 1:40 P.M. It was a shiny silver in color. It had a disc-shaped bottom with about four windows. The top was dome-shaped with only one window.

I was the first one to see it. It was spinning and moving swiftly. It went behind a tree and did not come from behind it. I was curious so I kept on looking. This is when my girlfriend saw it too. It came from where it came before, then disappeared behind the tree again. The bell rang to go to my first class, so I could not look at it any more.

It made no sound that I could hear. The day was a clear, bright, and fairly warm one. When I saw the UFO it was distinct and clear. It wasn't far from the school and it was about 50 ft. above the roof - tops of the houses. My friends and I saw it for about 1 min. 31 sec. It was Nov. 23, 1966 in Natrona Heights. We all are 12 years of age and in 7th grade.

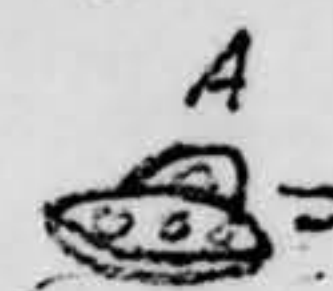
